3. Liaise with Pickleball Canada and other provinces / territories to exchange information and collaborate regarding national officiating initiatives. Identify priorities and supports for consideration at the national level.
4. Provide the PA Board with periodic updates on the numbers of accredited and certified referees and the status of initiatives related to officiating education, training, and tournament organization.
5. Provide support and assist aspiring referee candidates to achieve their goals.
