Learn about NCCP Coaching
The NCCP Pickleball Pathway is the
cornerstone to Canada's coaching
program and is geared towards people
who not only love playing pickleball,
but who want to help other people
enter the sport and to play it better.
This includes local ambassadors
committed to growing the game,
instructors and coaches tasked with
refining skills, and even club managers
who need to plan and deliver great
pickleball programming.

Currently there are two levels offered through the NCCP Pickleball Coach Education Program. They include: Instructor 1: Introducing Pickleball. This one-day course is focused on preparing instructors so that they can ensure that a new player's first experience with Pickleball is safe, inclusive and incredibly fun. Participants will learn to manage groups, organize play and focus on key fundamentals so that new players are set up for success and go home sharing a passion for Pickleball. This Level includes the completion of a 3-hour online portion in advance of the one-day in-person session. Instructor 2: Developing Recreational Players is focused on supporting instructors who can help existing Pickleball players to play the game better. With an increased focus on intermediate tactics and technique, this course takes place over two-days and prepares instructors to develop in their players a wide range of key skills that they will need as they advance.



A reminder that "ALL" clubs are required to have all members sign the waiver upon registration


